Ladders are used to create sets, as well as mobiles that transport performers across the stage. To add to the breadth of this extraordinary work, MOTUS O performs their version of *The Little Match Girl* to an original classical score composed by An-Lun Huang.

The Little Match Girl Revisited is full of comedy and pathos and is suitable for anyone who has a passion for the human condition.
